SECTION 3 – HIBERNIAN GRAND CHAMPION

Mrs G Kehoe – Tara GrCh OSCAR SAMANTE-BOHEMIA (BSH c) M 17.04.2022

Super lilac boy of good size and confirmation. Excellent rounding and width to head, very balanced with medium ears nicely blending into the rounding of his head. Short moderate nose, level bite and firm chin. Round gold eyes with nice expression. Excellent body, Coby well developed with good boning across chest and legs. Large rounded paws. Coat short, dense though slightly soft, of excellent sound frosty pink lilac, really nice tone. Tail in good balance with body. Super natured boy and a pleasure to handle.

Mrs A R Richardson – Sup GrCh C-ZEUS ML (BSH b 33) M 12.12.2022

Large well-developed chocolate colourpointed male. Very broad rounded head with well-developed cheeks, short moderate nose, level bite and fair chin. Medium ears a little open at base for balance to head, though showing a good broad top of head. Lovely well-developed body, compact with broad chest, stocky legs and large paws. Short dense crisp coat. Magnolia body colour shaded with warm chocolate in keeping with the points, which were well filled on legs, mask, ears and tail. My only criticism was that his mask extended over the top of his head rather than remaining on the facial area. Tail in good balance to body. Again, a lovely natured boy.

Miss K O'Neill – Int Ch GOTHAM PAY PER VIEW (BSH a) M 08.07.2021

Four-year-old blue boy with very nice balance to head and good width across the cheeks. Short moderate nose with level bite and firm chin. Medium ears nicely blending into the contour of his head. Lovely round expressive gold eyes. Good short dense, crisp coat of mid-blue colouring, slightly paling to the roots. Excellent body of good boning with solid legs, though standing a little tall. Broad chest and very good confirmation. Tail in good balance to body. Nice natured boy.

Ms J.K. Kirnaja – Ch DIVINEYES MAO OF MITZURO (BSH ny 12) M 03.10.2021

Just over four-and-a-half-year-old golden tipped boy. Small framed and I would prefer to see more size and substance for his age. Fair rounding to head with cheeks still filling out. Short broad moderate nose, level bite and rather shallow chin. Round green eyes with good distinct black liner. Medium ears nicely positioned with a broad top of head. Long rectangular body which really needs to have more substance. Coat showing fair density, slightly flat and long along the spine line, though displaying very nice black tipping throughout body and head with a rich golden undercoat. Black paw pads and white under chin. Tail in good balance with body. Nice mannered boy.

Ms J.K. Kirnaja – Ch AURUM BLOSSOM DANAYA (BSH ny 12) F 11.09.2022

Golden tipped female of three years and eight months, showing a nicely balanced round head with good width across. Good open expression. Short moderate nose, level bite, chin fading away slightly. Medium ears fitting well into the contour of the head with fair width across the top. Nice round green eyes with distinct liner.

Coat dense with a fairly good texture, showing even tipping throughout the body with a pale warm golden ground colour. Body is long and needs to be more compact. Fair boning to legs and paws, with black pads though these tipped exhibits really need more British confirmation and substance to them. Tail in good balance to body. Friendly girl and easy to handle.

Mrs G Kehoe – Ch FEDERICA OF LAST HOPE (BSH a) F 04.09.2022

Three years seven months old blue female showing good width of head. Short moderate nose, level bite and fair chin. Quite balanced in her head with very nice round gold eyes, though these could have done with some cleaning prior to the show. Ears rather open at base but showing good width between. Long body needing more substance to her, standing tall on legs. Flat open long coat, very unsound and banded in blue colouring. Feeling quite generous really for her to warrant this award today, as she really was not 100% in show condition. Tail in good balance. Handled well.

Mr M Mckernan – COCOBROWNIE BOUNTY HUNTER (BSH b)

Nice mature boy for his 11 months of age. Very good broad head with cheeks well filled, showing very nice rounding and balance overall. Medium ears nicely blending into the contour of his head with good width between. Short moderate nose, level bite and firm chin. Round, quite striking expressive gold eyes.

Very good body developing good width of chest with nice boning to legs and paws. Coat showing fair density, short and of a rich chocolate colouring with minimal paling to the roots. Tail in good balance to body. Handled well.

Ms J.K. Kirnaja – FURRYBLISSLOVE BOSIK (BSH b)

One year five months old boy lacking in head development and cheeks. Short nose, bite level, muzzle rather prominent. Round lemon eyes showing a distinct green rim at the moment. Medium ears open at base with fair width between. Long body standing tall on legs with fair boning. Short dense coat of warm chocolate colouring, though paling to the roots and quite unsound. Not a very happy chap being handled. Tail in balance to body. Hopefully his temperament will improve.

Miss K O'Neill – MISCHIEFCUTIES COCO CHANEL (BSH b)

One year seven months old chocolate female. Nice rounding and width to her head, with medium ears fitting well into the contour and showing good width between. Short moderate nose with level bite and firm chin. Super round gold eyes, very striking expression.

Longer in body than I would really like, though she is young and has time on her side. Good boning to legs and paws. Coat rather open and flat, needing more density. Chocolate colouring sound at present. Tail in good balance to body. As she is still young, I have given her the benefit of the doubt with her CC. Nice natured girl.

Mrs I.K Kisieliene – TIFFANY FORTIUM COR (BSH b)

Baby of the class at just nine months and 17 days old. Fair rounding and width to head, though needing much more time and substance for development. Head showing rather a pinched muzzle. Broad moderate nose, level bite and dark round gold eyes.

Body again needing more time and development. Coat unsound and rather flat, a darker shade of chocolate paling to the roots with lighter ticking down the spine. Tail in good balance to body. Handled well.

Mrs C C Cosma – XSILION ADORABLE CAT (BSH o)

Well-grown male of 11 months old. Very nice balance for his age with a full broad rounded head. Short moderate nose, level bite and firm chin. Very nice round gold eyes with good expression. Medium ears fitting well into the contour of his head with good width across.

I liked the body development for his age, showing a short compact body, stocky legs and rounded paws. Coat short, dense and of nice crisp texture. Warm sound cinnamon colouring of very nice quality. Cat showing a lot of potential. Tail in good balance. Handled well.

Ms J.K. Kirnaja – FURRYBLISSLOVE SABRINA (BSH p)

Young girl of one year three months. I would have liked to see more development to her head at this age, though she has a straight broad nose, level bite and chin. Round gold eyes with nice expression. Medium ears with fair width between.

Body starting to develop but needing to be more compact. Coat dense and crisp, though could have been better groomed as she was losing a great deal of coat while being judged. The fawn shade should show more of a rosy mushroom colouring; this was rather cold in tone, although the coat colour itself was sound. Tail in good balance to body. She handled well.

Mrs G Kehoe – SKYOTA CANDUIT TOYA (BSH c)

This boy is just over nine months old and showing very good balance for his age, with a broad head and very rounded cheeks. Short broad nose, level bite and firm chin, though the muzzle was a little pinched. Very expressive deep round gold eyes. Medium ears nicely placed into the contour of his head with good broad width between.

Great body with stocky legs, compact frame, broad chest and rounded paws. Coat also super, being sound crisp frosty lilac, dense and short. Tail in good balance to body. Handled well.

Mrs I.K Kisieliene – AMBERKISS XENNA (BSH c)

Young girl of one year and 11 months showing nice development for her age. Good width and rounding to head. Short broad moderate nose, chin rather shallow though bite level. Round expressive gold eyes. Medium ears nicely placed with a broad top of head.

Body developing well, compact with good bone to legs and paws. Excellent coat of sound lilac colouring with a slight silvering, though of good texture and length. Tail in good balance to body. Handled well.

British Blue Adult Male

Hills AstroCharm Benny Boom

Super boy in great condition and showing great development for his age. Lovely broad rounded head with full cheeks. Short broad nose level bite, firm chin

Round gold eyes, colour and expression very striking. Medium ears blending into the contour of his head. Very good compact body with broad chest, good boning to legs and paws. Coat short, dense with an excellent texture. Mid-blue colouring, just with a darker band of blue colouring along spine line

tail in good balance to body, handles lovely.

Kirnaja's Furry Bliss Love (Baks)

Small lean boy not overly large for age but with good rounded head, nice distinct gold eyes, medium ears with good top of head. Unfortunately standing rather tall on long legs and needs more substance to his overall confirmation quite fine boned. Coat short but a silvered blue but sound of fair length and density

Tail in good balance to body, handles well.

British Blue Adult Female

Nice girl of 11 months old, well developed. Rounded head starting to fill out in her cheeks. Round gold eyes with nice expression. Short broad nose, level bite, firm chin. Ears nicely rounded and with good width between. Body again needs to fill out. Coat short, crisp and dense of sound mid-blue colouring. tail I . balance with body Handled well.

British Cream Adult**1CC & BOB****Boheme Blazing Sun**

Cream male of one year and nine months. Nice size for his age with good development to head, though needs more fill across cheeks. Very nice expressive round gold eyes. Short moderate nose, level bite, chin rather shallow. Medium ears opening at base but with good width between. Large framed boy showing good bone to his legs and paws, just needs to fill his frame with development. Coat short, crisp and dense of warm cream, with adolescent ghost spotting at present, tail ringed but in good balance to body. Handled well.

British Blue-Cream Adult Female**1CC & BOB STEELE****AstralCharm Glitter Cascade**

Blue-cream girl, very attractive for nine months. Super broad balanced rounded head with full cheeks. Short broad nose, level bite and firm chin. Round striking gold eyes with nice open expression. Ears very rounded, just a little highly placed on top of head, but with good width between. Body excellent, really compact with very nice development for her age and good bone to legs and paws. Coat crisp, short and dense. Very nice mid-blue colouring with mingling of warm cream throughout. Attractive smudge of cream on eye extending down to nose. Two solid feet back and front, the other two broken with colour. Tail in good balance to body. Handled well.

British Tipped Adult Female**1CC & BOB****Kirnaja Iremoobr Alma**

Black tipped girl of two years 11 months. I would like to see more development for her age. Fairly good rounded head with broad cheeks. Short broad nose, level bite. Round pale green eyes with distinct black liner and good brick red nose leather. Fairly good body, though I would still prefer a more compact shape. Coat short with fair density, showing even black tipping throughout complemented by pale silver ground colouring, showing very good contrast from tipping colour to body undercoat Tail in good balance. black pads Handled well.

British Colourpointed Male

McKernan's Irebabbr Anakin

Seal point colourpointed male of only 11 months and showing really nice development for his age. Excellent round broad head with really good well-filled cheeks. Short broad nose, level bite and fair chin. Very nice round blue eyes with open expression. Medium ears fitting into the contour of his head with very good width between. Coat could be crisper, but short and dense. Body compact with strong boned legs and paws. Attractive magnolia body colouring with shading in keeping with his seal points, which were well filled on his mask, ears, legs, feet and tail. Very good contrast from body colouring to points. Tail in good balance. Excellent natured boy and well deserved his award.

British Colourpointed Female

Richardson's CelticMoonPaws Cleo

Attractive chocolate point colourpointed of just one year and two months. Youngster showing good fill to her rounded head. Lovely striking round blue eyes. Short broad nose, bite level, just a little pinched in her muzzle, fair chin. Medium ears nicely placed with good width between. Body starting to take shape and needs to be more compact, but she is still young. Nice boning to her legs and paws. Very good coat, short, dense and crisp. Clear magnolia body colouring with chocolate points starting to fill well on her ears, legs and tail. Mask needs more time to extend across muzzle. Tail in good balance to body. Handled well.

British Golden Tipped Adult Male

Cosma Happy Whiskers Ramis

Two years 11 months and not really conforming to the correct colour pattern for the breed. Fairly good round head and width. Short broad nos, bite level chin falls away, Good green eyes, though a little bulbous for expression. Fairly good body, legs and paws, but his coat was his downfall. Long coat with a very cold ground colour, not showing any warmth to the golden ground colour and his tipping blended into his ground colour without any distinct definition between tipping and ground colour. The coat on his back was clumpy and not well prepared. His colouring was better across his face and feet, but really is not the standard you would expect of this breed. Tail in good balance to body and handled well
