year old seven month old Red Self Devon Rex had of a good size and weight. Head muscular body, legs in proportion to the body with oval paws, the tapering tail balanced the body. Broad fairly short wedge to the heel, slender neck, large wide based rounded tipped ears set low and wide apart, the brow curved back to the flat skull. Nice sized oval shaped green eyes set well fairly short nose showing a reasonable stop in profile. High wide cheek bones, whisker breaks, rounding to the muzzle, level bite and firm chin. Head nicely balanced. Coat short

year old eleven month old blue Borneo

in proportion to the body with oval paws,

tip and balanced the body. Rounded
chest, broad short wedge to the
head. Medium sized ears, wide based
with rounded tips showing a slight
forward tilt in set, the brow comes
back to a slightly rounded top of
head. Nice sized golden toned eyes
with the top lines slanting toward
the nose and the lower lines nicely
rounded. Short nose with a nice
break to the profile, broad blunt
muzzle, level bite and firm chin. Hears
well balanced. Coat fairly short and
quite close lying having a slightly
open appearance, some old coat still
present, the coat was of a fairly
even toned blue colour showing a
slight pinkish cast. Unfortunately

head of a nice size and weight. Reasonable
length body, quite sleek, muscular, legs
in proportion to the body with large rounded
paws - the rounded tipped tail balanced the
body. Broad Medium wedge to the head
showing rounded contours and was slightly
longer than it was wide. Medium sized
ears, wide based with rounded tips set
well. Nice sized oval shaped green
eyes set well. A slight concave curve
to the nose profile broad rounded
muzzle, level bite and firm chin. Head
nicely balanced. Coat short, of nice
density, fairly soft texture, the coat
displayed a fairly clear silver ground
colour and black markings. There was
a little more tan shading to the coat
than I would have liked. Good
facial markings, rosette pattern to the
body, barring and spots to the legs,
spotted ticking and rings to the tail

Broad short wedge to the head. Medium sized ears, wide based with rounded tips showing a slight forward tilt in set. The brow curved back to a slightly rounded top of head nice sized chestnut coloured eyes with the top lines slightly slanted towards the nose and the lower lines were rounded. Short nose with a good break in profile. Broad blunt muzzle, level bite and firm chin. lovely head balance. Coat short, fine in texture and close lying. The coat displayed varying shades of red to the tortie. Glazing and a good ticked tabbying throughout. Super less, good temperament.

MAINE COON SILVER TABBY SERIES KITTEN MAKE

(MCO ds0322) (MW) 29.11.25. A five month old Red silver classic tabby Bi Colour head of a good size and weight for his age, long body developing good

bone and muscle tone. long tapering (5)
nicely furnished tail balanced the body.
Broad head with large ears well
feathered and tufted held high with
a nice gap between. Nice sized fairly
round golden eyes of a slightly oblique
aperture and set. Nose of a uniform width
with a shallow concave curve to the point.
Broad square muzzle, level bite, quite
nice width and depth to the level chin.
Head balance developing well. Litter
Coat of a nice length quite well prepared.
Just a little curly behind the ears and
on the chest, soft texture, white areas
pristine, white to chin, chest, tummy and
legs. red markings slightly muted due
to the silver gene, tabby markings to
the face, ears and coloured areas of legs.
Some ring to the tail. The body shows
rather unclear tabby markings,
silver ground colour; not sure if
in time this end up being a
real silver shaded and white water
but only time will tell, no need
to rush; benefit of doubt time at
this stage, good temperament.

month old tortie silver classic tabby has
who I would have preferred a little

larger for her age. the long nicely (6) furnished tapering tail balanced the body. Broad head, large ears well feathered and tufted set well. round eyes of a slightly oblique aperture and set, golden in tone, just a little deep set. Nose of a uniform width with a shallow concave curve in profile. Broad square muzzle, level bite quite nice width and depth to the level chin. Head balances coming together. Vulture Coat of a nice length well prepared, soft texture. Coat displayed a silver ground colour, black markings overlaid with varying shades of red. Good facial markings. Reasonable classic toby pattern to the body, barring to legs and up to the tail. A little shy, good temperament.

(BEN n 22) (MN) 30.12.25 A four month old lad of a nice size and weight for his age legs in proportion to the body with rounded paws. The tail slightly tapered to the rounded tip and balanced the body. Nice breadth to the medium wedge of the head slightly longer than it was wide developing nice rounded contours. Medium sized ears, wide based with rounded tips set well. Nice sized and shaped gold toned eyes set well. Slight dip to the nose profile. Broad rounded muzzle, at this stage the bite was slightly over scissor. Fur clean. Head developing nice balance. Coat short, soft in texture developing density. Good facial markings, dark brown markings on an orange ground colour, barring and spots to the legs, scattered ticking, a few rings to the tail, the body was rather dark, the marbled pattern was fair a bit of a mixture of classic and Marble good temperament

BROWN (BLACK) SPOTTED BENGAL KITTEN FEMALE

1st & BOB FLEMING'S LYNAVIDS CARAMEL KISSES

(BEN n 24) (F) 30.12.25 A lovely four month old lass of a nice size

and weight for her age, legs in proportion to the body with rounded paws the tail did slightly taper to the rounded tip and balanced the body head breadth to the medium wedge if the head slightly longer than it was wide and showing rounded contours fairly small ears wide based with rounded tips set well. Nice sized oval shaped gold toned eyes set with slight dip to the nose profile, barely broad rounded muzzle, level bite and firm chin, very good head balance. Kitten coat short of nice density, soft texture, dark brown markings on an orangey golden colour. Good facial markings, barring and spots to the legs, spotted tummy, rings to the tail. A super well defined clear rosette pattern to the body. Beautiful girl, lovely temperament. (Congrats on the B.I.S WIN!)
2nd FLEMING'S LYNAVIDS BLISSFUL DAYZE.

(BEN 24) (F) 8-12-25. A four month old less of a nice size and weight for her age. Legs in proportion to the body with rounded paws. The tail slightly tapered to the rounded tip and balances the body. Fairly broad medium wedge if the head slightly longer than it was wide developing rounded contours. Medium sized ears, wide based with rounded

tips set well, nice sized oval shaped (10)
hazel toned eyes set well, slight dip
to the nose prob., quite nice rounding
to the muzzle, bite slightly over scissor
at this stage. firm chin, head balance
coming together. better coat short of
fair density and soft in texture, dark brown
markings on an orange ground colour. nice
facial markings, barring and spots to the
legs, spotted turning over rings to the
tail. the rosette pattern to the body
wasn't as well defined and clear as
her sisters. Good temperament.

3rd FLEMING'S LYNAVIDS SOBBIE DAZZLER

(BEN 124)(F) 8.12.25 A four month
old lass of a nice size and weight for
her age. legs a proportion to the body
with rounded paws. the tail did slightly
taper to the rounded tip and did
present a fault towards the tip,
balanced the body. Reasonable breadth
to the medium wedge of the head
slightly longer than it was wide.
developing rounded contours. Medium sized
ears, wide based with rounded tips
set well. nice sized oval shaped
hazel toned eyes set well, slight
dip to the nose prob.: quite nice
breadth to the rounded muzzle. her
bite and firm chin. Head balance coming
together. better coat short of reasonable

density, soft in texture, dark brown markings on an orange ground colour. Good facial markings, barring and spots to the legs, spotted tummy, rings to the tail good well defined rosette pattern to the body. Good temperament.

EGYPTIAN MAU KITTEN FEMALE.

1st Bob ERVING'S ACCLAIM RUMI.

(MAU NS 24) (F) 19.9.25 A seven and a half month old black silver spotted female of a medium size and weight for her age. Graceful body developing nice muscle tone, legs in proportion to the body with dainty rounded paws. The gently tapering tail balanced the body. A medium slight rounded wedge to the heel. Nice sized ears, broad to the bases fairly pointed slightly floored and set well. Large rounded almond shaped green eyes set well. Nose of a uniform width with a shallow concave curve to the profile a fairly level brow over the eyes, gently rounded muzzle, level bite and firm chin. Head developing good balance. Uppers Coat medium length, close lying, developing resilience in feet. Good facial markings, barring and spots to the legs, spotted tummy, rings to the tail, the body displayed a fairly clear well defined black spotted dappled pattern. Good temperament.

DEVON REX NEUTER FEMALE

1st PC & BOB LEVSHINA'S IRIS VOM GABORLAND

(DEX no 322) (FN) 23.4.21 A five year old lass of a nice size and weight. Hered muscular body, slim legs in proportion to the body with oval paws. the slender tapering tail balanced the body. slender neck. Broad short wedge to the heel. Large ears, wide based with rounded tips set low and wide apart. the brow curved back to the flat skull. nice sized oval green eyes set well. she did tend to round them slightly, short nose with a good stop in profile, high wide cheek bones, whisker breaks, rounded muzzle, level bite and fairly firm chin. very good heel balance. Coat short displaying very good overall coverage, soft in texture and shows very good warmed waxing throughout. Good temperament.

SPHYNX NEUTER MALE

1PC & BOB HARTE'S NUDELOOK MISTER NOTORIOUS

(SPH w64) (MN) 5.6.25 A young nearly eleven month old head of a good size and weight. Hered muscular body, rounded chest, legs in proportion to the body with oval paws and long slender toe. the long tapering tail balanced the body. Modified wedge to the heel slightly longer than it was wide showing

rounded contours. large ears, wide (13)
open based tapering to rounded tips set
well. Flat plane in front of the ears
nice sized lemon shaped eyes of
a yellowy green tone set well. Good
cheekbones, whisker break and rounded
muzzle, level bite and firm chin. Slight
break to the bridge of the nose.
Head well balanced, well presented,
chassis better feel to the body,
muzzled down over the nose. Good
temperament.

LYKOI ASSESSMENT NEUTER MALE.

SRM & BOB HARTE'S SHALNAVAZZ NIMBOO.

(LY5n) (MN) 15.11.24 A one year
and five month old black roan head
of a good size and weight. With firm
body, legs in proportion to the body with
oral paws, the tapering tail balanced the
body. Modified wedge to the head
showing rounded contours from nose to
cheeks, slightly longer than wide to the
wedge. Large ears wide based, pointed
just a little flared in their set. Round
oval shaped green eyes set well.
a gentle concave curve to the nose
profile. A whisker break, rounded puffed
out whisker pads. - level bite and firm
chin. Head nicely balanced. Medium
to short coat with minimal undercoat
and coverage of ground hairs. Fairly

Nice sized golden toned eyes which were showing their top lids slanting towards the nose and their lower lids rounded. Unfortunately she was showing a noticeable squint to both eyes good break to the nose profile. Broad blunt muzzle. Level bite one firm claw. Head developing nice baler coat short, fine in texture and do lying body showing a rather cool toned chocolate tortie colouring, better tone to ears and head at this stage.
